

**GRAND PALACE HALF DAY TOUR**

**(Morning & Afternoon)**

**Morning 7:30 am. Afternoon 11:30 am.**

- 07:30 Pick up from your hotel (in Bangkok)
- 08.30 Group will be transferred to **Wat Phra Kaew**, the chapel of **the Emerald Buddha**, which houses the world's most precious image of the lord Buddha , the 75 cm. statue of jade sits atop an 11 m golden pedestal surrounded by lavish mural and richly decorated pavilions. Then group will be moved to visit the grand palace which encompasses several major building. The most prominent buildings include the throne hall. The reception hall and the coronation hall.
- 12.00 Return to the hotel.



The Grand Palace features some of the most spectacular architectures in Asia. The Palace compound is a treasure house for Thai arts and houses the Emerald Buddha, the most sacred Buddha image in Thailand. This is the perfect introduction to Thailand, the Buddhist faith, regal splendor and tradition. Though no longer the royal residence, it remains the symbol of the kingdom. You'll visit the key attractions around the Grand Palace including Wat Phra Kaew-Temple of the Emerald Buddha, Coronation Throne Hall, Royal Reception Hall, Royal Funeral Hall, the Golden Chedi, and the Royal Pantheon. Wat Phra Kaew is Thailand's most sacred temple, so please do not wear shorts, sandals or T-shirts. Certain buildings in the Palace grounds are closed on Saturdays and Sundays..
